



Announcement issued by the Energy and Minerals Regulatory Commission (EMRC) for licensing Distribution Natural Gas Companies in Amman and Zarqa

The Energy and Minerals Regulatory Commission, in accordance with the power granted by the Petroleum Products Law No. 11 of 2018, which entrusted the Commission with the responsibility of granting permits and licenses for persons working in the natural gas sector, announces to those who are interested in obtaining a license for distributing Natural Gas in Amman and Zarqa by networks as announced on the website of the Ministry of Investment /Public Private Partnership unit to submit a letter of intent with the supporting documents to EMRC according to Law No. 8 for the year 2017, Petroleum Products Law No. 11 of 2018 and the Licensing by-law No. 121 for the year 2019 and its amended No. (8) for the year 2023 and the Instructions of Importing, exporting, transporting, distributing, selling and storing natural gas and liquefied natural gas and any related activity.

The interested parties should submit in fulfillment their letters of intent the supporting documents that include, but not limited to the following: -

- ✓ The interested party should be either a single business entity, joint-ventures, consortia, partnerships or other combinations of business entities composed of members, local or international.
- ✓ The interested party must have at least 10 years of experience in building networks for distributing Natural Gas.
- ✓ The interested party should have at least 10 years of experience in management and operation of distributing natural gas networks.
- ✓ The interested party has a positive net operating income over the last three-year period.
- ✓ The interested party must demonstrate that the total debt as a percent of total capital does not exceed 80% (the audited financial statement of 2022).
- ✓ The interested party should submit a letter of commitment with the applicable laws and the requirements for the operating of this business to the by-laws.



- ✓ The paid capital for the interested company is not be less than (one) million Jordanian Dinar.

The EMRC will not reimburse any costs incurred by the interested party in preparing and submitting the required documents. The interested party shall incur all such costs.

By submitting its documents , each of the interested party releases EMRC and its advisers, irrevocably, completely and unconditionally, from any and all liability for claims, losses, damages, costs, expenses or any other liabilities in any way related to or arising from the review of documents related to ,and associated decision-making process regarding, this announcement.

The interested parties are hereby notified that EMRC retains the right to suspend or cancel the procedure at any time at its sole discretion without any liability to the interested party and without any obligation to give reasons.
